

Whether it's for your home or your business, New Jersey's **Clean Energy Program™** makes using renewable energy technologies affordable, practical, and just plain smart.

What is the Renewable Energy Manufacturing Incentive?

New Jersey's *Renewable Energy Manufacturing Incentive (REMI)* program currently provides rebates to New Jersey residents, businesses, local governments, and non-profit organizations that purchase and install solar energy equipment like panels, inverters, and racking systems.



Who is eligible?

For Customers - Available for the first 500 kilowatts (kW) of a solar project, rebates for panels start at \$0.25 per watt. Rebates for racking systems and inverters start at \$0.15 per watt. To be eligible for an incentive, applicants must begin by applying to either the *Renewable Energy Incentive Program (REIP)* or the *SREC Registration Program (SRP)*. *REIP* and *SRP* registration and enrollment applications collect *REMI* eligibility information. There are no standalone *REMI* application forms. *REMI* is not available to owners of completed projects or projects that have already been approved and accepted into the program as of September 23, 2009.

For Manufacturers - To become a certified New Jersey manufacturer under this program, companies must supply documentation that products have been manufactured with at least 50 percent of the product cost – including the labor, overhead, components, and raw materials – from facilities located in New Jersey. Products must comply with applicable Underwriters Laboratory (UL) standards of product safety certification and be commercially available to the public. A yearly manufacturing audit will be performed to ensure continued manufacturing compliance.
