

GET PAID TO GET ENERGY-EFFICIENT

For a limited time only, *New Jersey's Clean Energy Program™* is making financial incentives and rebates available to non-investor owned electric utility customers and those who heat with oil and propane. Select portions of the program are available for businesses, local governments and homeowners. These incentives have been made available through the federally funded State Energy Program (SEP).

For Businesses and Local Governments

Direct Install

This program provides up to 70% project funding for existing small to medium-sized facilities to cut energy costs by replacing lighting, HVAC and other outdated equipment with energy-efficient alternatives. To be eligible, you must have a peak electric demand that did not exceed 150 kW in any of the preceding 12 months and work with a pre-qualified trained Contractor.

Pay For Performance

This program takes a whole-building approach to energy efficiency with incentives up to 50% of total project costs. To be eligible, you must have an existing facility with a peak demand in excess of 100 kW in any of the preceding twelve months and work with an approved Pay for Performance Program Partner.

Local Government Energy Audit

This program delivers a comprehensive energy audit for governmental and select institutional facilities with incentives covering up to 100% of the cost. To be eligible, you must be a municipal or county governmental entity, New Jersey State College/University or a 501 (c)(3) non-profit agency and select from a list of Pre-Qualified Auditing Firms.

For Homeowners

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR®

This program offers whole house solutions to improve your home's comfort and reduce energy costs by up to 30%. A Building Performance Institute contractor will perform a home assessment identifying energy-efficient recommendations. The program provides up to \$5,000 in incentives plus 0% financing to pay for the improvements.

WARM Advantage

This program provides incentives of up to \$400 for installing, or replacing existing, high efficiency heating equipment such as furnaces, boilers, and water heaters.

COOL Advantage

This program offers up to \$500 in incentives to New Jersey residents for installing, or replacing existing, energy-efficient central air conditioners, ductless mini-split AC systems, and/or heat pumps. Contractors check to ensure that the cooling equipment is properly sized and operating efficiently.
